


The USB cable must be connected to the monitor's USB port and the DVR's USB port to enable the touch screen function.

The DH100 Series DVRs can be controlled with a touch screen monitor (not included). Touch screen monitors must be Windows 7® Touch compatible to work with the system.

NOTE: A firmware upgrade may be required to enable touch screen compatibility. Firmware upgrades are available as a free download from www.digimerge.com.

Step 1 of 3: Connect the Cables

USB Cable: Enables the DVR to recognize touch gestures on the monitor.VGA Cable: Transmits video from the DVR to the touch screen monitor.AC Power Cord: Provides power to the touch screen monitor.

Step 2 of 3: Power on the Monitor

Step 3 of 3: Test the Touch Screen Functions

Before you start:

- 1. Make sure your monitor is turned on.
- 2. Power on your DVR.
- 3. Wait for the DVR to boot into the main viewing mode.

Access Quick Menu

• While in viewing mode, press and hold anywhere on the screen for 2 or more seconds. Then remove your finger to open the Quick Menu.

Navigate Menus

- Tap to select menu options.
- To exit menus, press and hold anywhere on the screen for 2 or more seconds. Then remove your finger. If you have made any setting changes, you will be asked if you want to save changes.

Select Split Screen View


• In the Quick Menu, tap one of the Split-screen view selectors to open split-screen view.

Select Channels in Full Screen

• While in a split-screen display mode, double tap on a channel to view it in full screen. Double tap again to return to split-screen display mode.

Access Playback Mode

- In the Quick Menu, tap boots to enter Playback Mode.
- Tap the on-screen controls to control video playback.
- To exit Playback Mode and return to viewing, press and hold anywhere on the screen for 2 or more seconds. Then remove your finger.
